Match Font is available on Adobe Photoshop CC 2015 and further updates. He works with Adobe Typekit to help you find fonts and reproduce them in your own work. You must log into Adobe Typekit online with your Creative Cloud username. Open the image in Photoshop to get started. Step 1. From the menu, go to The Type of Match Font. Step 2. The capture box is superimposed on the font in the image file. As close as possible to be able to capture the capture box by the type you want to identify. Photoshop offers fonts from those stored on your computer. Click on the font to make it active, or click on the star next to the font to mark it as a favorite for longer use. Step 3. Put a tick on a small box that says show fonts are available to sync with Typekit. Photoshop displays a few more matches for you to choose from. There is more than one way to pin the font used, but now the match tool in Photoshop is another powerful shovel to dig in and get the font you appreciate. You can then edit the text within that layer. As you change and move the text in Adobe Photoshop there are two ways to access and change existing text. For a simple approach, do the following: Choose a text tool from a toolbar or using a T keyboard shortcut. The second method requires that your panel layers be open, but you don't need to have the text tool selected: Open the panel layers, moving on to the layers. In the Layers layer list, find the text you want to edit and double-click on the large T button. Then you can click in this text to choose, delete or add more text. To move the text, do the following: select the Move tool from the toolbar or use the keyboard shortcut Click directly on the text on the canvas and drag the move without releasing the mouse. Mixing text with images is easier than you think, if you need to add text to your photos in Photoshop, there are different ways to do this as shown above.
